

SUBJECT: ADDENDUM #5 NOTICE

Let this memorandum serve as a notice of information regarding the “**Contract No. 2 Water Treatment Plant, Pipelines, and Well Houses (RE-SOLICITATION)**”.

As originally stated, below are questions collected from Firms interested in this Invitation for Bid (IFB) with NTUA responses as follows:

1. Information regarding Indian Preference. **Preference will be applied to qualified Indian-owned businesses. Preference priorities as defined in the Navajo Business Opportunity Act (5 N.N.C. § 204 A) will not be used in determining Indian preference. Preference is given to any Indian Owned business regardless of Tribe affiliation. Bid opening procedures will be as follows:**
  - a. All bids submitted by Indian Owned businesses shall be opened first.
  - b. NTUA shall determine the qualifications of the bidders based on their bid response to the requirements in the bid documents.
  - c. The award shall be made to the qualified Indian Owned bidder with the lowest responsive bid among Indian Owned bidders, provided the Base Bid does not exceed the maximum feasible price or cost.
  - d. If no qualified Indian Owned bidder is entitled to award, bidding will then be open to all other bidders, subject to the same qualifications in the bid documents. Award shall be made to the bidder offering the lowest price, provided that the bid is less than or equal to the maximum feasible cost or price for the Base Bid.
