- 5. Project Description & Scope of Work Darryl Bradley, Navajo DOT
 - a. Project Plans, Roadway Cross-sections, Contract Book, and Geotechnical Report are available for download from the Navajo DOT website (http://www.navajodot.org/RFP.aspx).
 - b. Funding Source is Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Tribal Transportation Program funds.
 - c. Scope of Work consists of: Proposed work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and incidentals necessary to construct 0.24 miles of grading, subgrade, placement of aggregate base course with stabilization, installation of drainage structures, bridge replacement with abutment protection, traffic signs, and other miscellaneous work.
 - Replace existing single-lane, 409-foot long, steel military-style bridge with new 5-Span bridge.
 - Existing Road and Bridge Work Area will be closed to the public. See Sheet 30 of the Plans for Proposed Detour Route access to I-40 at Allentown Road Traffic Interchange, which is approximately 10.5 miles west of the Work Area. Bidders are strongly advised to drive the proposed detour route to look at road conditions, types of traffic signs needed for the detour in accordance with MUTCD and note locations of all culverts and bridges.
 - North access road from I-40 to Work Area goes under the BNSF Railroad.
 Bidders need to check railroad bridge clearance height for delivery of
 materials, etc. to the site. Access road under BNSF Railroad also doubles
 as a drainage way for flows coming from the north to the Rio Puerco River
 during storm events.

- 6. Coordination with BIA Navajo Region Division of Transportation (NRDOT) Derek Meier, WCI
 - a. Project was designed by the BIA NRDOT and Harold Riley is the Engineer of Record.
 - b. Selected Contractor will need to work with the BIA to obtain a Permit to work inside BIA right-of-way.
 - c. The Contractor's construction contract is with the Navajo DOT. All coordination with the BIA NRDOT will be conducted by the Navajo DOT.
- 7. Utility Coordination is the responsibility of the Contractor See Article 7.1 of the EJCDC C-700 Standard General Conditions and Section 107.02 of the FP-14 Specifications.
- 8. Navajo Nation Business Regulatory Department (BRD) Ernie Pahe, Navajo Business Regulatory



- Navajo Business Opportunity Act (NBOA) purpose is to give first opportunity and preference to qualified Navajo and Indian-owned businesses. The BRD monitors procedures on bid openings to ensure compliance with NBOA.
- b. All proposals must have the contractor's return address on it. Under Procurement Rules and Regulations, Section 11, states without exceptions, packets without identification will not be opened and will be deemed "Non-Responsive".
- c. Scoring of Certified Priority 1 and Priority 2 Contractors See Page 5 of RFP, Section R, Sub-Section d under Certified Navajo Business 0 -10 points. A Certified Priority 1 Contractor will receive 10 points and Priority 2 Contractor will receive 5 points.
- d. The General Contractor (GC) must include a Subcontracting Listing and must review the subcontracting listing on the BRD Source List to find a qualified subcontractor. The main intent of the NBOA is to hire qualified Navajo business when you are looking for a subcontractor. If the GC cannot find a qualified subcontractor from the BRD Source List, then the GC can go outside and use other source lists to select a qualified subcontractor.
- e. If any Contract Modification(s) are processed during construction, these modifications will be reviewed by BRD as part of the Section 164 Review Process.

 - b. Page 5 of RFP Under Section P, all work performed on this project is subject to the 6% Navajo Nation Sales Tax.
 - c. Page 5 of RFP Under Section R, the proposal evaluation procedures, criteria, and scoring criteria is listed. We include scoring for Certified Priority 1 and Priority 2 Navajo Nation vendors.
 - d. Page 6 of RFP Under Section T and U, the proposals will be opened and evaluated in accordance with the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act and Subcontracting Requirements. Website links are included for contractor's reference to the NBOA and Source List of Certified Navajo Businesses.
 - e. Page 7 to 11 of RFP Outline of Request for Proposal
 - f. Proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope with a return address. If no return address is included, proposal will be deemed "Non-Responsive".
 - g. Bid Schedule must be submitted in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked as "Bid Schedule RFP #20-05-2317LE Project N9402(2)1,2&3".
 - h. Prime Contractor requirements Self-Perform 50% of the work. See Special Contract Requirement Clause NN-236-1.
